hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981
modifying the definitive map and statement for the county of Kent by upgrading to a
restricted byway the footpath EE66 from Corner Drove at Ordnance Survey grid reference
TR28476139, to Paramour Street at the corner near Lower Paramour Farm at
TR28976154, and to the extent necessary, to add the restricted byway between the same
two points.
