In the parish of Stelling Minnis, beginning on Eastleigh Court Road at the northeast corner of Eastleigh Wood (Ordnance Survey grid reference TR14314539), proceeding 230m east-northeast across and ascending a pasture field to join Sandy Lane (also known as High Minnis), 310m northeast of Sandgates cross-roads (TR14524543), then resuming 10m further northeast along Sandy Lane (TR14534544) and proceeding 240m southeast, along the north side of a fence, to a minor road (alternatively known as High Minnis or Wheelbarrow Town Road) south of Wheelbarrow Town (TR14744531). A total distance of 480m.
