hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the county of Kent by:

1. Adding a byway open to all traffic known as part of Coombe Road, beginning at a junction with the way recorded as bridleway ER218A at Ordnance Survey grid reference TR27194116, and following Coombe Road east-northeast below Joiners Hill for 220m to a gate at TR27384125.

2. Upgrading bridleway ER218A to restricted byway beginning at the southeastern corner of Poulton Farm at Ordnance Survey grid reference TR27024124, and following that bridleway in a southeasterly direction for 180m to TR27194116, then easterly, then resuming southeasterly, direction for 410m to a junction, 140m west of Soval Pond, with footpath ER218B, bridleway ER217 (also known as Back Lane), and bridleway ER219 at TR27524099.

3. Upgrading footpath ER218B, part of Back Lane, to restricted byway beginning 140m west of Soval Pond at Ordnance Survey grid reference TR27524099, and following that footpath east for 140m to Soval pond at the junction with footpath ER192 at TR27644100.

4. Upgrading bridleway ER217, part of Back Lane, to restricted byway beginning 140m west of Soval Pond at Ordnance Survey grid reference TR27524099, and following that bridleway west and then southwest for 1,060m to Eight Acres at TR2660405).
