hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981
modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding the restricted byway
(between A and B) and upgrading the public footpath EE446A (between B and C):

From the Coldblow road 140m north-northeast of Ripple Cross at A (at Ordnance Survey
grid reference TR35624872), and passes north-northeast along and within the east edge
of a copse for 210m to the parish boundary at B (TR35714891), then continuing in the
same direction for 300m (in the line of public footpath EE446A) along the remaining edge
of the copse and across an arable field to terminate on Ripple Road at C (TR35914914)
approximately 30m east of the centre point of the passing bay.
