hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the county of Kent by upgrading to a bridleway the footpath HE287 and part HB23, in the parishes of Saltwood and Hythe, from Saltwood Castle at the junction with bridleway HE285 (adjacent to a bridge under former Hythe and Sandgate branch railway), to Blackhouse Hill, adjacent to no.27; and by adding to the particulars relating to the footpath HE287 by providing that a width should be recorded.
