hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981
modifying the definitive map and statement for the county of Kent by adding the restricted
byway:

Beginning on Selson Lane immediately west of and opposite Great Selson Farm
(Ordnance Survey grid reference TR30045558), along a track, initially paved, north-
northeast along the west side of a headland, for a distance of 610m to a junction with
Drainless Road (TR30325611).
